An educational and fun activity has been organized to engage Year 10 students in STEM DAY, as part of Field Study Day, Term 3.

The STEM Day workshops will be run by Engineers Without Borders, an organisation from UNSW dedicated to creating social value through engineering. They aspire to promote humanitarian engineering and teach young people the problem solving skills necessary to engineer a better world. Students will participate in four workshops where they will build floating houses and prosthetic legs and use their higher order thinking skills to solve problems involving renewable energy and improving health.

These workshops have been planned to supplement the work being done in the classroom in all relevant KLAS. The workshops will expose students to the skills needed to produce a creative solution to difficult problems, make decisions by working as a team and plan their design and then build it within a restrictive budget.
