Sign in to your...

Student Portal and open up your email.



- Check if you have any emails from your teachers.

G-Suite and open Google Classroom.

- Check your school timetable for what subject you normally have on that day/period.
- Click onto the Google Classroom for that subject, check the STREAM for any tasks and/or updates from your teacher.
- To see your course material for that subject, click CLASSWORK


(Alternatively, if you click the 'three line' menu dropdown tab at the top left-hand corner. Click on 'To-do'. Here you will see all the tasks you need to complete and any assessments that are almost due.)

- Click on a task if you want to check any comments that your teacher or classmates have made about that activity.



Moodle

- Moodle is another platform for your teacher to communicate with you and send you work or activities to complete.
