

Dear Parents/Carers,

All students studying Mathematics from Years 7 to Year 10 are required to use Maths e-Learning, which is a web-based learning program that integrates home and school learning via the internet.

At a small cost, students have at their fingertips both revision and practice for every topic studied. Teachers are able to assign specific activities for students to complete in class or at home, but most importantly students are able to review and revise learned concepts themselves by regularly logging into the program and finding topics they need to practise.

The benefits of Maths e-Learning are;

- students are inspired and motivated to learn
- responds to individual student strengths and weaknesses
- students instantly know if they are on the right track and can work through the curriculum at their own pace
- animated support guides students through concepts whenever they need, like a maths tutor might do
- teachers can monitor student records in order to track progress and identify learning needs.
- NAPLAN practice papers for Year 7 and 9 students

**Maths e-Learning is a compulsory component of studying Mathematics** and all students have their participation and completion of work recorded and reported upon.
