

SPORT 2021

Dear Parent/Carer,

The school's sports program is recommencing in 2021 for Years 7 to 11, subject to COVID-19 guidelines. In preparation for a return to the normal sport program each **Wednesday** 12.55pm -2.47pm, students are required to select either a **Grade Sport** where they compete against other schools in the St George SSSA zone or a **Recreational sport**.

CHANGES TO SPORT SELECTION

- 1. Sport choices for 2021 will be via an emailed online form.
- 2. **Parent/Carers are then required to** print and **sign** the selection form as an acknowledgement of the requirements and costs involved.

IMPORTANT: Once you have submitted your online choices it will form part of your timetable. **No sport changes will be permitted when sport commences. Payment for Grade sport** is required at the beginning of the season, **no refunds** will be issued as fees are based on student numbers. The same applies for external providers for our recreational programs.

- 3. Dismissal from the home venue for <u>Grade sport</u>: Sport played at our home venues may finish as early as 2.00pm and students can be dismissed from the home venue directly. If a student would like to be dismissed from the home venue at the conclusion of the game and make their own way home, then the Parent/Carer must choose that option on the online form and a signature will be required on the printed form.
 - Permission to leave **competitor venues is not permissible**, students must return to school with their team coach on the bus. The bus does make a stop at Canterbury Station where students may alight.
- 4. Dismissal from the venue for Ice skating, Tennis lessons, Canterbury Leisure and Aquatic Centre. Dismissal from these venues is at 2.30pm with parental/carer permission only.
- 5. Read the sport choices over the page carefully, including the costs involved before you make your selections. Choose a sport that is affordable for your situation.
- Complete the online form as soon as it becomes available as <u>numbers are limited</u> for each sport.
 Once the quota has been reached you will be <u>locked out of choosing that sport</u> and you need to make another selection.
- 7. Students who do not make a sport choice by the end of the allocated cut-off date (see online form) will be allocated a sport by the sport coordinator.

Grade sport information.

Game draws are posted on the *Sports Notice Board* before each round, usually on the Monday.

Competitor School List: Beverly Hills Girls, Blakehurst High, Kingsgrove High, Kingsgrove North, Kogarah High, Moorefield Girls, Peakhurst High, Penshurst Girls and St George Christian School.

Travel: Students walk to home venues or take a school organised bus to the competitor venue.

Recreational Sport: Students walk to and from the venue. Home venue dismissal is at 2.47pm.

Uniform: Full school sports uniform and appropriate sport footwear. Some sports require safety equipment, which the girls will need to provide themselves. Students need sun protection and water for sport. Students who do not wear full school sports uniform will be unable to participate in sport and will be sent to Sport Theory until 3.10pm. **Sportsmanship:** All students are to always display good sportsmanship. Unacceptable behaviour/attire may result in permission to attend being withdrawn and the cost of sport will still apply.
